the media; the revenue!**

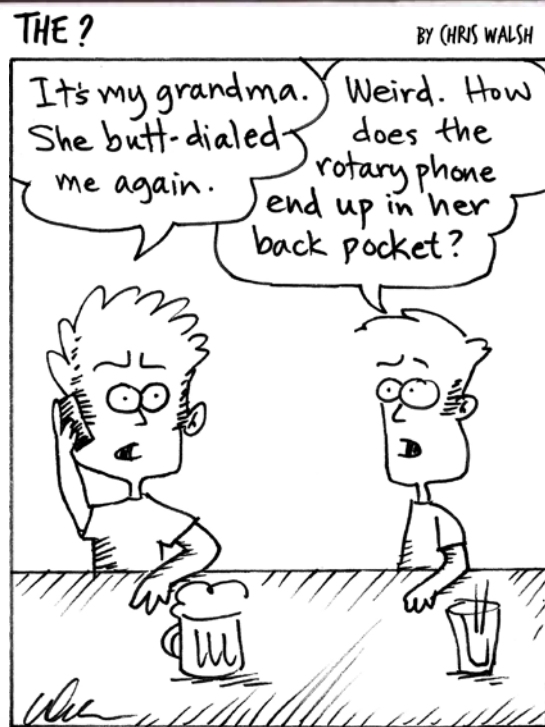
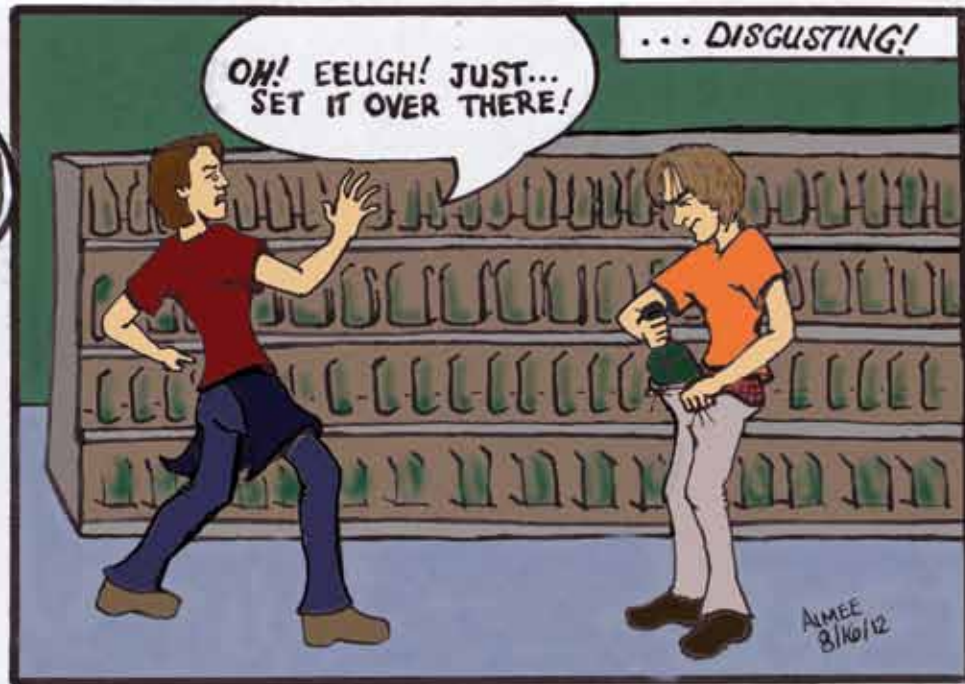
**But never mind all that my love.

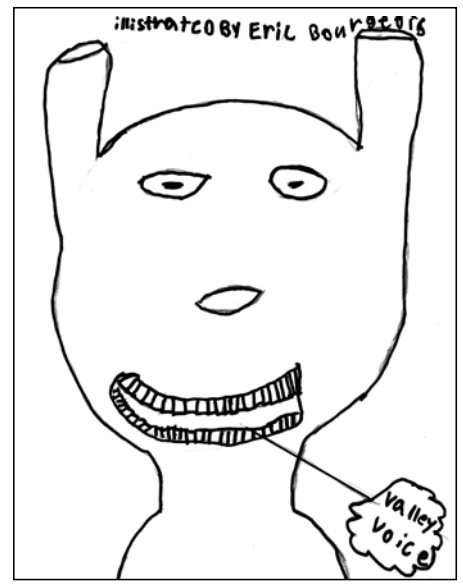
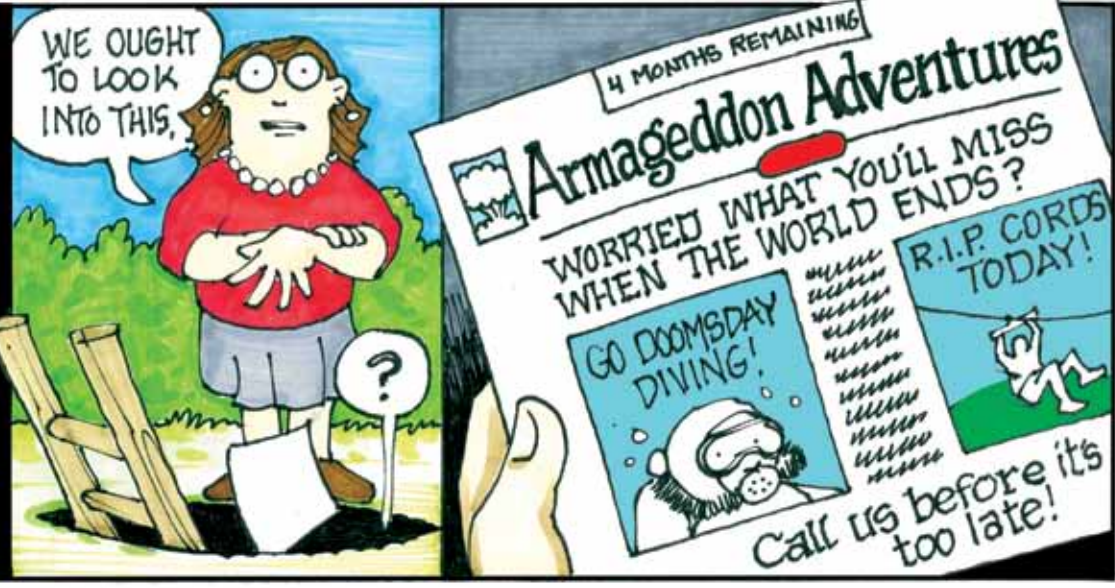

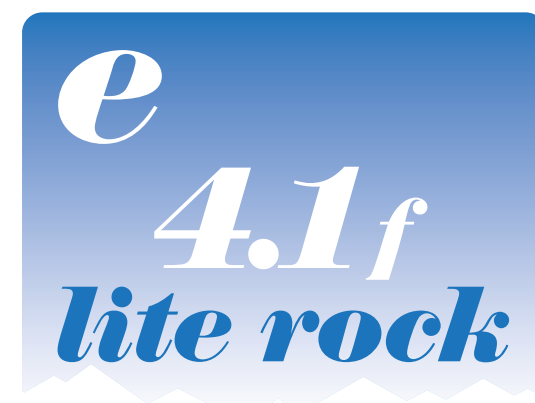
